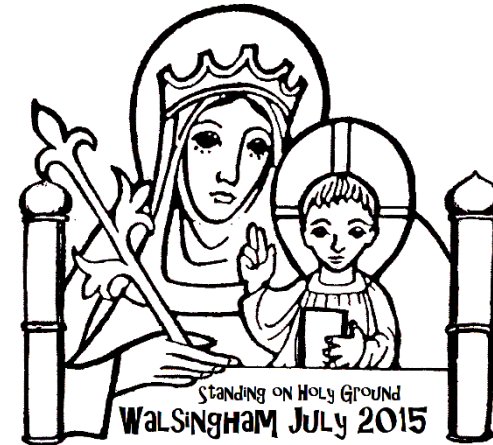

## OFSJB Conference: Pilgrimage: Standing on Holy Ground

**3 -5 July 2015**

### Keynote presentations will be given by:

**Metropolitan Kallistos of Diokleia** is Assistant Bishop in the Archdiocese of Thyateira and Great Britain. Metropolitan Kallistos has led many pilgrimages both in this country and overseas. He is deeply involved in the dialogue between the Orthodox Church and other Christian Traditions at an international level.

**Dr Nicholas Fennell** has taught Russian and French at Winchester College since 1975. He is the author of *The Russians on Athos* and of numerous articles about Russian Athonite history and literature. He will speak about the Russian tradition on the Holy Mountain.

**Protopresbyter Pancratios Sanders** is the parish priest of the Church of St Barbara in Chester, within the Archdiocese of Thyateira and Great Britain. He has organised pilgrimages within the British Isles, for nearly three decades. Most notably to the shrine of St. Winifred at Holywell, North Wales.

**Archpriest Philip Steer** is a priest of the Russian Orthodox Church in Great Britain and Ireland, Diocese of Sourozh and serves as the caretaker of the Pan-Orthodox Chapel within the Life-Giving Spring of the Mother of God, situated within the main Anglican shrine at Walsingham. He will speak about the Orthodox presence at Walsingham itself.

During our visit we will pray and worship at each of the three Orthodox Churches within Walsingham itself.

The Conference will be hosted within the Anglican Shrine at Walsingham. Staying at the Shrine offers a unique experience as each accommodation building nestles within the shadow of the Shrine Church, giving the sense of pilgrimage.

The accommodation offered is all of a good standard but can be quite varied. However, please let the conference organiser know, in time, if there are any particular accessibility issues or needs.
