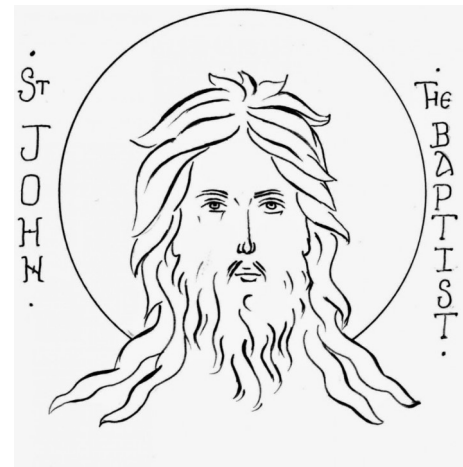

He was for several years Senior Fellow in Patristics and Church History at the University of Oxford, as well as Chair of Theology in Leeds. Among many scholarly publications, he wrote the book *Of God and Man: Theology as Anthropology from Irenaeus to Athanasius*. Vladyka Irenei is a popular and engaging speaker.
